




Tiered approach for registrations (article 23)





Direct obligations



- Classification and labelling
- Check SDS requirements
- of compounds
- Check classification and labeling (CLP)
- Check SDS requirements
- Presence and Concentration of Candidate substances
- Check for restricted uses
- Check for authorisations

Substitute risky substances






