DETAILS OF THE PROCESSING ACTIVITY

PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING ACTIVITY

Collection of participant data for the carrying out of training courses (including preparation, participant lists, name badges, attendance lists, certificates) and proposals and invoicing as well as an optional use for inclusion on a waiting list.

Collection of personal data from concerned persons for the performance of services (preparation and implementation of orders, storage of contact data in an internal database to ensure communication with clients, naming of contact persons in contracts, letters, emails, invoices, etc.) for these persons or their employers.

LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING ACTIVITY

The processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or in order to take steps prior to entering into a contract in accordance with Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR.

DATA TRANSFER TO A THIRD COUNTRY

The controller plans data transfer to a third country.
